
- Design an intuitive layout solving for many features (internal transfer, external transfer, P2P, M2M, A2A, C2C) | CUSTOMER REQUEST

Main Feedback

- Quick actions drew their attention first on screen users liked icons
- Weren't clear on what the three dots were (more Quick Actions, hiding the widget)
- Liked the Quick Transfer option
- Easily found how to start an internal and external transfer
- Easily found how to add or edit Payees
- History was also clear for viewing historical transfers
- Users liked the question format for "Who do you want to pay?"
- Verbiage for Myself and Someone seemed to make sense to users


"I preferred "A" - seemed easier, logical. I felt more secure and confident through the process"


Main Feedback

- Users were wanting the Quick Transfer option here
- Confusion around "Most Recent"
- Confused by initials in Most Recent card
- Some users missed the "Activity" button at the bottom
- Felt like it was lacking in usability
- No one picked Option B as a favorite
- Make Transfer vs Send Money wasn't overall clear to users

"I didn't know what FL meant and I found it super confusing"

"Activity and payees get lost at the bottom of the screen"




- Recent Payees drew attention
- Users were not confident in how to complete an internal transfer
- A lot of information on the screen
- Layout reminded a user of their current banking app
- One user did not like "Payee" term used

"I prefer screen layout C. I like it because the options are much more clearly presented. The only suggestion of improvement would be to highlight the what would you like to do box with a blue header or something to make it stand out more"




Main feedback

- Users thought the top button titles were too long and requested simple titles instead
- Users enjoyed having a way to view history that wasn't in the way of other important information
- Three users said they would not utilize quick fill amounts
- Users enjoyed having a flow on the main screen to save time
- Every user was able to make a Quick Transfer

Option A is more intuitive and I find it easier to follow.




Main feedback

- Users thought the top buttons were easier to understand and simple
- Users predicted they would only add 4-8 people in Quick Transfer (mostly family members)
- Four Users said they had no need to see History on main screen but wanted the option to view it elsewhere
- Two did not see a need or want for the Manage button


Both designs are simple and I feel like I would use Option A more because I don't have a need to view my History in Option B


Things are visually grouped together really well.. it has clear sections that are defined and have a clear purpose.






